<b>Communion</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>* Sunday 8:30 and 10:15 Services <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Celebrant washes hands in Sacristy before Communion</li> <li>- Floor markings to ensure social distancing</li> <li>- Communion in one kind (bread only)</li> </ul> </li> <li>* Sunday 10:15 Service <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Spiritual Communion Prayer will be available on the Livestream</li> </ul> </li> <li>* Wednesday Noon Service <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Celebrant washes hands before Communion</li> <li>- Intinction following Bishop's guidelines possible</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

<b>Children's Ministry</b>	* Activity packets available for children who attend worship service * Sunday School with vaccinated teachers following social distancing and other safety guidelines
<b>Nursery</b>	Moving toward opening with vaccinated helpers
<b>Church Offices</b>	Clergy and staff return to regular office hours
<b>Small Groups</b>	* May meet following social distancing guidelines * Continue meeting virtually if desired  <i>For small group gatherings where all attendees are fully vaccinated, face masks and social distancing are not required.</i>
<b>Community Outreach</b>	* Hot Meals – Yes (with social distancing) * Coates Food Bags – Yes (with social distancing) * Arbor Terrace Service – Yes (Morning Prayer) – Social distancing required – Limited to two vaccinated people from Epiphany
<b>Baptisms</b>	Yes (First one scheduled in July 2021)
<b>Confirmations</b>	Yes (First one scheduled in January 2022)
<b>Weddings</b>	* Yes, attendance limited by social distancing guidelines * Social distancing required * Face mask required
<b>Funerals</b>	* Yes, attendance limited by social distancing guidelines * Social distancing required * Face mask required
<b>Social Distancing</b>	At least 6 feet apart at all times
<b>Face Mask</b>	* Required for everyone age 5 and over * Church has some masks available * Clergy may remove mask to preach * Lay Readers may remove mask when reading
<b>Sanitation</b>	* People wash hands before entering the sanctuary (Fellowship Hall sink or Family Bathroom) * Hand sanitizer stations available * Hard surfaces sanitized after every service / event
<b>Restrooms</b>	* Sign posted regarding proper hand washing * Paper towels readily available for opening door * Cleaned after every service / event
<b>Additional Safety Measures</b>	* Public health reminders signage posted * Internal doors propped open when in use * Staggered pew set-up * No Bibles, hymnals, pens in pews * Water fountains blocked off
